Energy Management Centre (EMC) was established in Thiruvananthapuram (Trivandrum), Kerala, India in February 1996 as an autonomous organization under the Department of Power, Government of Kerala. As such, EMC has got a functional framework devoted to comprehensive and multi-disciplinary institutional objectives and orientation encompassing all aspects of energy, with a focus on energy-environment-development interactions. The guiding philosophy and school of thought of the Centre is "achieving sustainable development through enhancing total energy efficiency and application of renewable energy and environment friendly energy systems in all sectors of the economy". Energy Management Centre, Thiruvananthapuram is the State Designated Agency to enforce the Energy Conservation Act 2001, in the State of Kerala. In 2003, UNIDO opened its first Regional Centre for Small Hydro Power in EMC. SHP Cell of Power Department, Government of Kerala is also functioning in EMC.

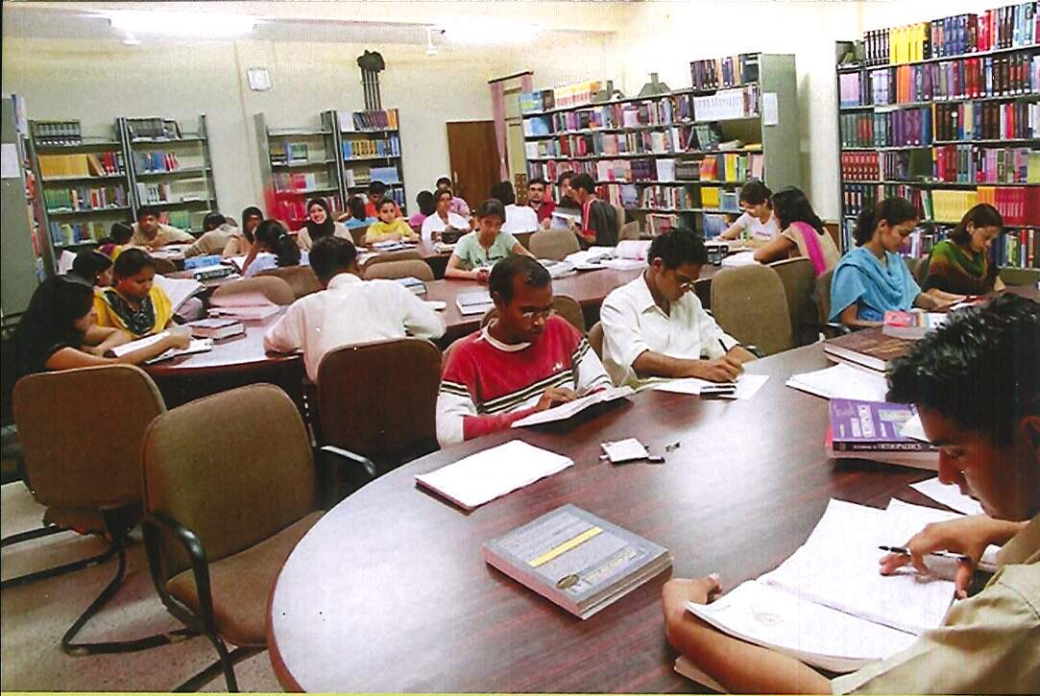
